WHO MUST FILE

- o Reports must be filed by each operator of Facility/Measurement Point which handles Federal and/or Indian Production.

WHEN TO FILE

- o Reports must be filed when an operator determines that the Facility/Measurement Point will begin handling Federal or Indian production.
- o Reports must be filed when a new operator assumes responsibility for a Facility/Measurement Point that has previously reported to the PAAS.

- o Report the Facility/Measurement Point Number. (See Reporter Handbook Appendices).

- o Report the Location Method Code and the location of the Facility/Measurement Point (See Appendices of the Reporter Handbook).
- o Report the name of the Facility.
- o Inventory Capacity must be left blank (used for Oil and Gas only).
- o Report the correct sub-action code for additions or removals of all scales or meters at the Measurement Point.
