WHO MUST FILE

- Reports must be filed by operators of Federal and/or Indian leases, that sell solid minerals subject to royalty after secondary processing.

WHEN TO FILE

- Reports must be received by MMS by the 15th day of the second month following the report period (e.g., the report for June is due on August 15).

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Report the source lease and product code for each product sold after secondary processing.
- Report the sales quantity allocated to each source lease from each selling facility.
- Report the MMS number for the selling facility.
- Report all sales quantities as whole numbers.
