


## Revenues by type from Federal offshore lands, Fiscal Year 1997 \*

NOTE: Boundaries for offshore State areas have not been legally defined beyond the area identified in section 8(g) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act Amendments of 1985, Public Law 99-272. Beginning in 1996, revenues from new offshore leases issued in the Gulf of Mexico employ American Petroleum Institute (API) Standard State Codes for offshore lands. These include both State areas identified by API and a general entry, "Gulf of Mexico," for areas beyond the standard API State areas. Revenues from leases issued before 1996 that were previously identified with a particular State area continue to be listed under that State in this series of tables.
